MN Organization on Fetal Alcohol Syndrome – Talking about screening of young children – how to ask the tough questions – Looking for red flags – important to ask questions to get accurate information – hard to ask birth parents if alcohol was consumed can be difficult – 1 in 100 effected. Many kids diagnosed at age 8 because that was when we start seeing some of the issues with executive function – willing to do trainings on how to ask the tough question – standard procedure to ask about this during intake – how can this get to their medical record so it can be followed – working to get rid of shame & blame – how can we be supportive moving ahead – what might be the disconnect and how do you go further if parent says 'yes' before I knew I was pregnant and then stopped – we often stop our questions at that time maybe need to take the next step – what might that be?
