## Suspension includes in-school, out of school, and bus when on special transportation.

| Suspended 1 to 4 <u>consecutive</u><br>school days  | <b>NO</b> Unless the removal brings the total number of cumulative days per school year to more than 10, or the parent requests a meeting   |   | NO  | NO                                |
| Suspended 5 to 10 <u>consecutive</u><br>school days<br>(Contact Director of Special<br>Education immediately)                             | <b>YES</b> Meeting MUST be held within 10 calendar days of the incident.  | NO Unless the removal brings the total number of cumulative days per school year to more than 10, or the parent requests a meeting. | YES   | <b>YES</b> (beginning on day 6)   |
| Removed 10 or less <u>cumulative</u><br>school days in a school year  | NO Unless you see a pattern in cause for suspension   | NO  | NO  | NO                                |
| Removed 11 or more <u>cumulative</u> school days Includes 45 day unilateral placement; Contact Director of Special Education immediately. | YES   | <b>YES</b> If there is a current FBA, it can be reviewed instead of conducting a new one.   | YES   | YES                               |
| In-School Suspension  | YES: An in-school suspension would be considered part of the days of removal unless the student is afforded the opportunity to:  1. Continue to appropriately progress in the general curriculum; AND  2. Continue to receive the services specified on their IEP; AND  3. Continue to participate with non-disabled children to the extent they would have in their current placement. |   |   |                                   |
